

# How to upload to IsumaTV with an FTP program

If you want to upload many videos at the same time or a video over the 500 MB limite you can do so by using an FTP program.

This exemple uses the free [FileZilla](#) program but many other programs existe.

1. Go to your channel on IsumaTV and click on **Video** under the UPLOAD menu of your DASHBOARD.

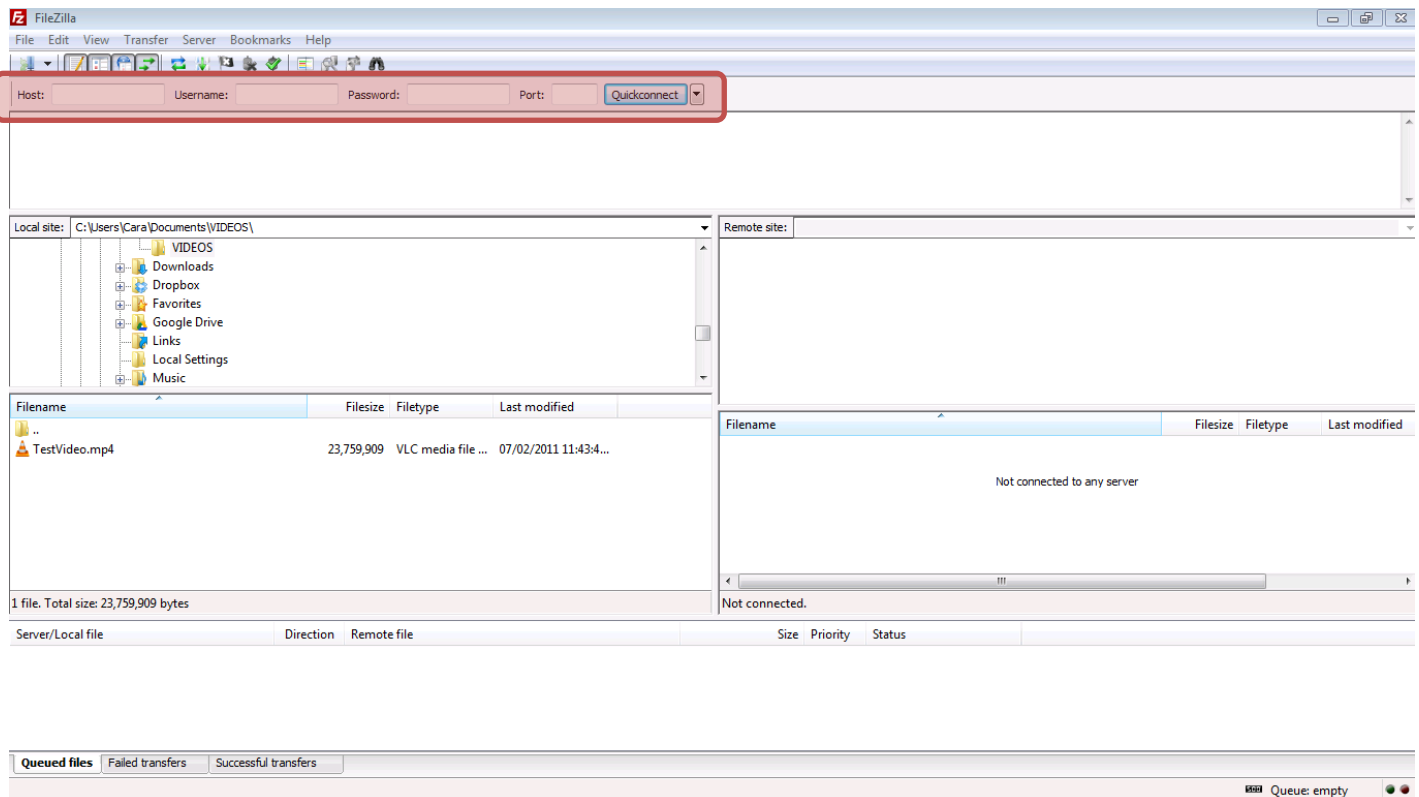
2. Write down your unique FTP username that appears in the HELPFUL TIP bubble to the right of the video selection button.

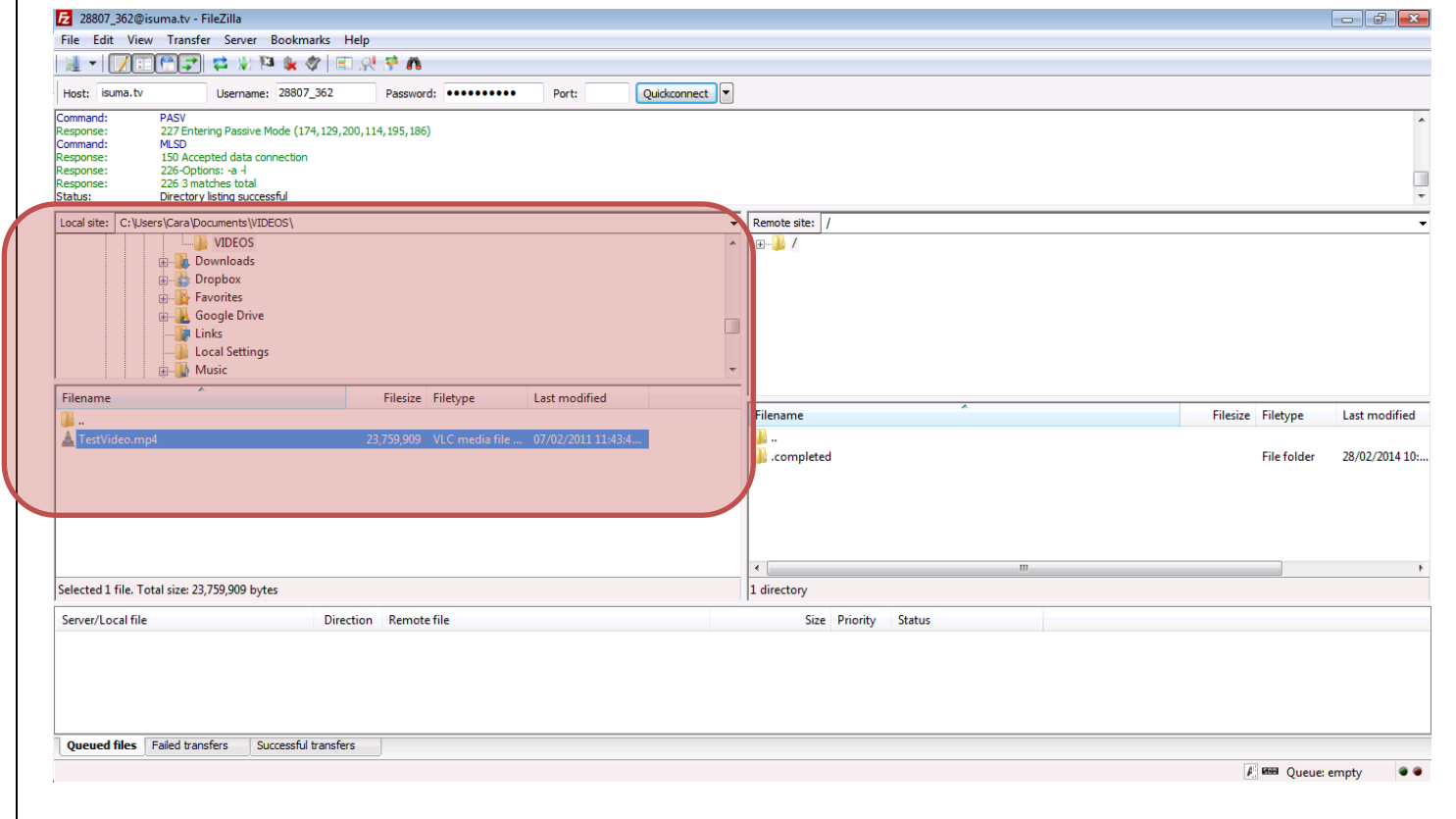
3. You can exit the IsumaTV upload page and return to your channel.

4. Open your FTP service (in this example, FileZilla) and connect to the IsumaTV server by entering the following information where requested and then click on **Quickconnect**:

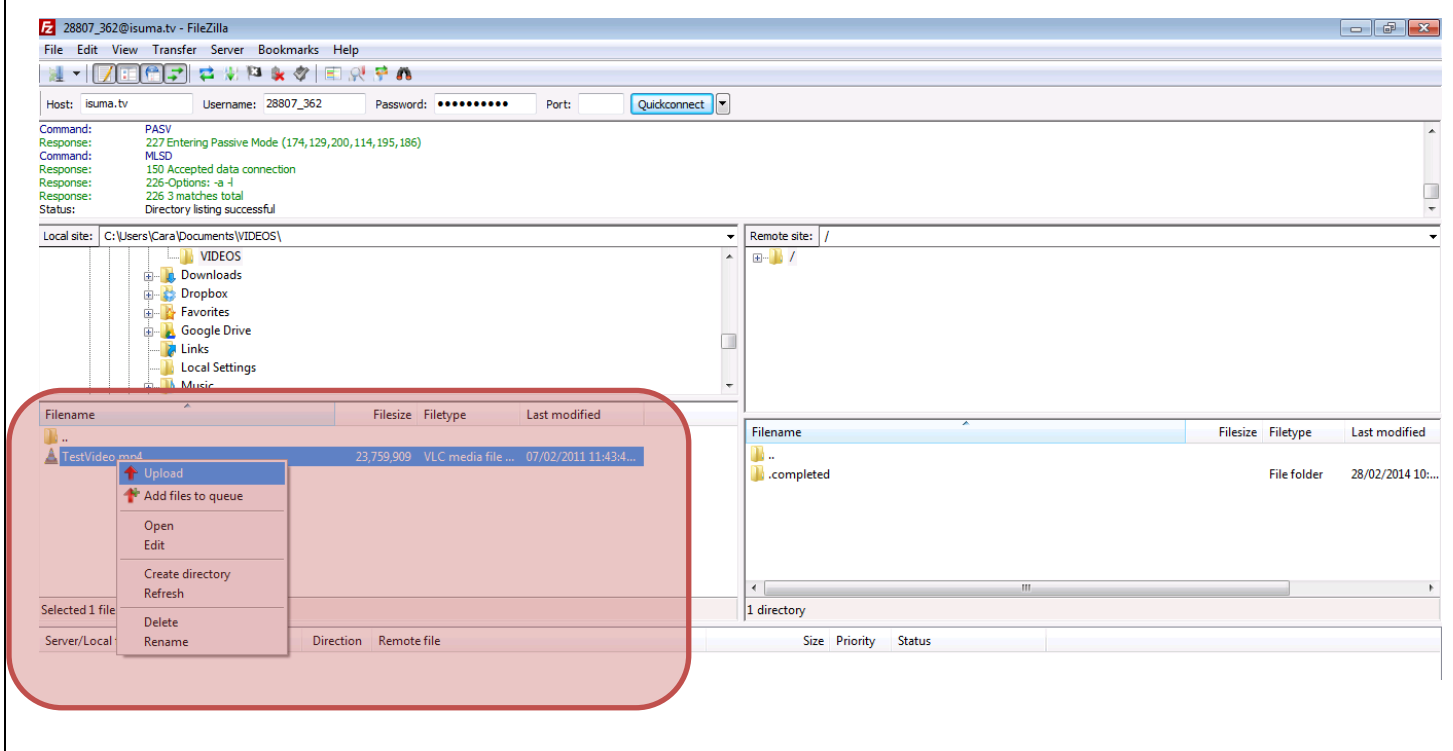
- Host: isuma.tv
- Username: the number taken from the IsumaTV upload page
- Password: your normal IsumaTV password
- Port: 21



5. Once connected, find your video file on your computer (under Local site).



6. Right-click on your file and select **Upload**.



## 7. Your video will begin to upload to IsumaTV.

## 8. Once the upload is complete, your video file will disappear from the *Queued files* tab and appear under the *Successful transfers* tab.
