at the Canada Pavilion at the 58th Biennale Arte 2019 in Venice, Italy, and broadcast live from Nunavut to global audiences.

Each broadcast will include footage filmed live from north Baffin Island and will include conversations with Igloolik hunting families on the impact and benefits of proposed mining expansion in the region.
